Thank you for participating in the SECO BottleDrop fundraiser. Recycling your eligible bottles and cans helps raise funds for student programs, school events, and enrichment opportunities at Sato Elementary.

How do I drop off my bottles and cans?

1. Fill your blue SECO BottleDrop bag with eligible bottles and cans at home.
2. Take the full bag to a BottleDrop location.
3. Scan the QR code on the bag to open the drop-off door.
4. Place the bag inside the drop door.

No BottleDrop account is required to participate. The QR code on the bag connects the donation directly to SECO.


Where and when can I drop off filled bags?

Bags can be dropped off at any BottleDrop location. Most retail partner locations accept bags daily from 8:00 AM – 8:00 PM. Hours may vary by location, so please check before visiting. Find a location near you: <https://bottledrop.com/locations/>

What can be recycled through the BottleDrop program?

You can include beverage containers (such as aluminum cans, plastic bottles, and glass bottles) that have an Oregon deposit value.

Unsure if your container can be recycled? Look for the Oregon deposit value on the can or bottle:



Only containers with the Oregon deposit symbol are accepted. Please do not include milk containers, juice boxes or cartons, wine bottles, food containers, paper cartons, other household recycling in your blue bag.

Do bottles and cans need to be cleaned?

Containers do not need to be washed, but they should be empty before placing them in the bag.
